- 1919, April 17; AAH 3/83
 - Grantee: North Chesapeake Beach Land and Improvement Company
 - Grantor: Doctor Thomas Fell, of Annapolis
 - Blocks C, D, E, F, and G
 - North Chesapeake Beach Land and Improvement Company mortgaged all of the land in North Beach except blocks 1 to 33 and is now asking for further lots that have been sold to be released from mortgage.
 - Deed of Release

- 1905, July 7; GWD 5/413
 - Plat of Subdivision of that part of North Chesapeake Beach lying east of Blocks 4, 5 and 6.
